


THE FOOD SYSTEM IS BROKEN

- Food system is responsible for 60% of global biodiversity loss
- 9 species account for 66% of total crop production


...TO BRING SOLUTIONS, STOP DEGRADATION




- > Zero net carbon 2050 GHG Protocol Corporate Standard scope 3

- Bringing the consumer along


