We understand the biodiversity curves and the climate curves. We want to mainstream unusual businesses bending these curves. Social sciences can help us understand human curves. Transition management practices can help us see how our society is moving. It can help identify who are the front-runners discovering the boundaries of the possible and the impossible in our countries. Our experience is that understanding their transformative practices and understanding the societal dynamics in which they are happening can accelerate mainstreaming.

#### a bold idea

We believe transition management is part of the solution and can help to engage others in bending the curves. We are looking for countries willing to explore with us how transition practices can become part of post2020 framework.
